

General Trip Notes for Lake Tahoe

Weekend Expedition

SWIM SCHEDULE

- 1) Saturday morning swim – one to two miles – 9:00 am
- 2) Saturday evening swim – one to one and a half miles – 6:30 pm
- 3) Sunday morning swim – one to two miles – 9:00 am

TIMELINE:

Friday night – check in to campgrounds. Campground Kiosks close at 10 pm, but you can enter after that and check in with the Ranger in the morning.

Saturday morning – meet at 9:00 am at our first swimming spot. We'll swim from 9:30 to 11:00 am.

Saturday is for you to do whatever you like.

Saturday night – meet at 6:30 at our swimming spot. We'll swim from 7:00 to 8:15 pm.

Dinner - we'll dry off, warm up, and meet in Tahoe City for a group dinner (optional)

Sunday morning – meet at our swimming spot. We'll swim from 8:45 to 10:00 am.

Checkout time from the campsite is 12 noon.

COSTS:

The \$195 fee for the trip includes the campground for two nights, one group dinner on Saturday night, and three group swims.

The non-swimmer fee is \$100, because our camping space is limited and non-swimmers take up potential swimmer space.

There will be additional parking fees at each of the beaches where we swim. Swim Art will reimburse you for these fees.

CAMPGROUND INFO:

Where: D.L. Bliss, Southwest shore of Lake Tahoe

Tents: You may have to share a tent with another swimmer. Each site can only hold two 4-person tents maximum.

Facilities:

This is a car camping site, and parking is included. It is also a group site. There will be approximately 4 swimmers per camping site, in 2 tents. Please note that

some of you will be sharing tent space. Bathrooms, potable water, and showers are available.

Food: Dinner will be provided on Saturday night. You are responsible for other meals (2 breakfasts and lunch on Saturday). So, you are welcome to bring what you like. There are grills at the campsites.

OTHER DETAILS:

Dogs will not be allowed on this trip. Water temperature will be 65 to 68. The air temperature is usually in the 70s or 80s, though occasionally there is rain in the summertime.
